Afternoon: Drive 8 mi downtown. Walk a section of the Tony Knowles Coastal Trail from Westchester Lagoon — Denali visible on clear days. Anchorage Museum if it is raining.

Dinner: Moose's Tooth Pub & Pizzeria. Line is real but the Spicy Bear is worth it.

Sleep: Lakefront Anchorage. Booking link in the live document.

Day 2 · Seward Highway

DAY TWO

Drive: Anchorage to Seward, 127 mi, ~2h45m. The Seward Highway is one of the most scenic drives in North America — budget pull-overs at Beluga Point, Bird Point, and Tern Lake junction.

Afternoon: Exit Glacier walk (1.5 mi roundtrip, well marked). Skip the helicopter unless weather is unusually clear.

Dinner: The Cookery. Reservation required, book before you fly.
